Thomas M. Hren, age 83, of Winchester, passed away Sunday, February 20, 2011, at home. He was born December 6, 1927, in Winchester to the late Martin and Edna (Omness) Hren. Tom was a Winneconne High School graduate. He served his country in the National Guard and then served in Korea with the U.S. Marine Corps. On December 18, 1961, he married Shirley Sternhagen. For over 30 years Tom worked for Kimberly-Clark, retiring in 1986, and after retirement he continued working for Bergstrom Corporation. Tom had an adventurous spirit all through his life and he was not afraid to try new things. In his younger days it was racing snowmobiles and motorcycles. In his later years, Tom took great interest in the Winchester Area Historical Society.
