It is with great sadness that we share with you the news of the passing of our beloved mother Delores "Dee" Luce. Her prayers were finally answered and she has been reunited with her husband of 65 years, Charles Luce, and the youngest of her children, Peter Jon, who lost a battle to cancer in January. Delores passed away on Wednesday, September 27, 2023, at The Residence assisted living facility in Oshkosh, WI where she had been a resident since July 12, 2023.

Delores was preceded in death by her loving husband Charles on December 1, 2011, and by her youngest son, Peter Jon Luce, who lost a four-year battle with cancer on January 10, 2023. In addition, Delores was preceded in death by two siblings, six of her late husband's siblings, and numerous close friends.

She was a generous person who looked forward to holidays and the opportunity to bring family and friends together.

A funeral service will be held on Monday, October 9 at 11:00 a.m. at the church with Pastor Julie Peterson officiating. Interment will be at a later date in the Winneconne Cemetery.
